Students who have not obtained a C- grade or higher in the SACE compulsory subjects, Research Project (10 credits), English (20 credits), Mathematics (10 credits) and Personal Learning Plan (10 credits) will be required to attend a compulsory boot camp after the completion of year 11 exams to lift their grades to the minimum requirement. Students who do not attend nor meet the requirements will not be able to commence a Stage 2 program in 2021.

3. The subjects you select should match your future pathway (University, TAFE, Apprenticeship or Full Time Employment), interests and strengths. Read the subject outline from the handbook and where applicable ensure you meet the minimum entry requirements for the subject.

4. University courses with pre-requisite subjects must be selected in Stage 2. University courses with assumed knowledge subjects should be selected in Stage 2. Please ensure you check the relevant SATAC information using <https://apply.satac.edu.au/info/coursesearch/?cycleCode=unis2020>
Please note if you are considering studying at an interstate university you need to check their specific conditions of entry as these may be different, for example many Eastern State Universities require a Stage 2 English/EALD subject.

6. If you are interested in applying for VET, you must complete a separate application form and submit it to The Hub by Friday 14 August. **If you have submitted a VET application you will only need to select three Year 12 subjects.**
