## SUBJECT SELECTION PLANNING TOOL

### INSTRUCTIONS – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

- ✓ Students select a total of 6 subjects per semester with 1 line dedicated to supervised study. Students who have submitted a VET application are still to choose 6 subjects per semester.
- You must achieve a 'C' grade or higher in PLP this year. If you do not attain a C grade or better, you will be required to repeat the subject during your study line in semester 1.
- You **MUST** select **Research Project** for **2 semesters** on the same line throughout the year.
- You **MUST** select an **English** subject for **2 semesters** on the same line throughout the year.
- You **MUST** select a **Mathematics** subject for **semester 1** and are encouraged to study a full year of Mathematics. If you wish to study any Mathematics at Stage 2 you must have studied a full year at Stage 1.
- If you are selecting **Mathematical Methods** you must select **A, B and C**. If you are selecting **Specialist Mathematics** you must also select Mathematical Methods A, B and C.
- If selecting a subject listed with a (year) after the subject name you must select it for Semester 1 and 2.
- If selecting a subject listed with a (semester) after the subject name you can only choose this subject once in semester 1 or semester 2.
- All other subjects can be selected in either semester 1 or semester 2 or for a full year.
- Some classes **may not run** in 2022 based on subject viability. You will be required to **select two additional next preference subjects**. It is important to choose these next preference subjects carefully as you may be allocated the class.
- Students can study a subject at either Gleeson College or Pedare Christian College if it is not available at Golden Grove High School.
- Some subjects may not be displayed in web preferences if you have not met the subject advice in the curriculum handbooks. For more information, speak to the relevant Learning Area Leader. - Enter your chosen subjects into Web Preferences.
