Students who have not obtained a C- grade or higher in the SACE compulsory subjects, Research Project (10 credits), English (20 credits), Mathematics (10 credits) and Personal Learning Plan (10 credits) will be required to attend a compulsory boot camp after the completion of year 11 exams to reach the minimum C- requirement. Students who do not attend nor meet the requirements will not be able to commence a Stage 2 program in 2022.

Please note if you are considering studying at an interstate university you need to check their specific conditions of entry as these may be different, for example many Eastern State Universities require a Stage 2 English/EALD subject.
